



Together, Debbie used her expertise in labour hire and Greg leveraged his background in the Australian furniture industry to build Winya's profit-for-purpose model that creates traineeships & apprenticeships for Indigenous people with partners across the Australian furniture industry.

For our unique approach to Indigenous empowerment, in 2018 Winya became the only company in Australia to be Awarded by the United Nations for leadership in sustainable development.

Winya maximises its procurement outreach programs with timbers from remote communities, fabrics from women's art centres and has created programs in Prisons to train Indigenous inmates to reduce recidivism & build better communities.
